Domain 2: Classroom Environment

2a Creating an Environment of Respect and Rapport

When I have my own classroom I will focus on having strong relationships with my students in order to create a culture of mutual respect and understanding. I will hold myself accountable for being the best teacher I can be and ask my students to do the same. I want my students to be able to follow my directions but also enjoy coming to school every day.
